- Met expectations. Could include an isolated minor lapse or two. "4" shall be the default score unless there are deficiencies per guidelines in 3,2, or 1
- Occasional mechanical lapses and/or inattention to the responsibilities of that category. But individual is giving a solid effort.
- 2 Consistent pattern showing lack of knowledge in the category and/or lack of effort or lack of cooperation with crew. Score of "2", written justification is required.
- 1 Little or no knowledge of that category and/or little to no effort. Actions detrimental to the functioning of the crew as a cohesive unit and integrity of the game. Score of "1", written justification is required.

Even if no single category is below a "3", written justification is required if the total score falls below 51 points.
